CAPR 52-16, 1 October 2006, is supplemented as follows:

**4-9. ADDED. Florida Wing Cadet Competition**

- a. **Purpose.** The purpose of the Florida Wing Cadet Competition (FWCC) is to provide a motive for cadet to study and practice elements of the cadet program while building a sense of esprit de corps.
- b. **Objective.** The objective of the competition is to select the representatives of the Florida Wing in the Southeast Region Competition.
- c. **Competition Program.** The FWCC includes the Florida Wing Drill Team and Florida Wing Color Guard Competition, which are held prior to the Southeast Region Cadet Competition annually. FLWG Pamphlet 52-4, *Florida Wing Cadet Competition* shall be used as the governing publication for the competition by authority of this supplement.
- d. **Awards.** The first place drill team and color guard teams, respectively, will have the honor of representing the Florida Wing at the Southeast Region Cadet Competition. Team members will be awarded a white shoulder cord as authorized by CAPR 39-1, Supplement 1, *Civil Air Patrol Uniform*.
